GENERAL GRANT APPROVAL GUIDELINES

- ❖ Funds shall be dispersed in the general service area of McKenzie Electric Cooperative, Inc. (MEC) solely for charitable, educational, scientific, health, or safety purposes.
- ❖ Organizations must be exempt from Federal Income Taxation under s501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code [the “Code”] as a corporation described in s501(c)(3) of the Code).
- ❖ No funds of the Trust shall in any fashion be used to support any candidate for political office or for any political purpose; or for economic development.
- ❖ Not more than \$2,500.00 will be given annually to any family unit, group, organization, charity, or like organization.
- ❖ The Board reserves the right to carry over applications to a later meeting depending on funds availability and other factors.
- ❖ The Board will disperse funds equitably throughout the MEC service territory as practical.
